

**KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,**

That we *Reuben Bearfield and Thomas Williams*  
are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Kentucky in the just  
and full sum of fifty pound; which payment well and truly to be made, we  
bind ourselves, our heirs, &c. jointly, severally and firmly by these presents,  
signed with our hands, and sealed, with our seals, and dated this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of  
*November 1830.*

Whereas there is a marriage shortly intended between the above bound  
*Reuben Bearfield* and *Miss Terresa Brown*  
for which a license has this day issued, now,  
the condition of the above obligation is such, that if there should be no legal  
cause to obstruct said marriage, then the above obligation to be void, other-  
wise to remain in full force and virtue in law.
