Hagan are here and firmly bound unto the commonwealth of Kentucky in the sum of ~~eighty~~ pounds current money to be paid to the said commonwealth to which payment well & truly to be maid we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, & admors jointly and severally by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this 23rd day of May, 1818

The condition of this obligation is that if there is no lawful cause to obstruct a marriage intended to be solemnized should be between the above bound Walter Boon & Mrs Elizabeth Mattingly by the widow of Joseph Mattingly deceased then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full
