sealed with our seals and dated this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October 1820


The condition of this obligation is, that if there is no lawful cause to obstruct  
a marriage intended to be solemnized shortly between the above bound  
John Boone & Miss Catharine Greenwell daughter of  
Joshua Greenwell

Then the above obligation to be void, else to remain in full force
