 verally, and firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this *20th* day
 of *January* 1818.

THE condition of the above obligation is such, that if there should be no legal cause to obstruct
 a marriage shortly to be solemnized between the above bound *Matthew*

Greenwell and Miss *Mary Amelia Greenwell*

for which a licence this day issued, then the above obligation to be void, else to remain in full
 force and virtue in law.
