

Know all Men by these Presents, That we,
Austin Howard and Leo Boone

of the County of Nelson, and Commonwealth of Kentucky, are held and firmly bound unto the said Commonwealth, in the full and just sum of Fifty Pounds (~~equal to one hundred and sixty six dollars and sixty six and two-third cents~~) current money; for the payment whereof, well and truly to be made to the said Commonwealth, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these presents, sealed with our seals, and dated this Fourteenth day of November 1853.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas there is a Marriage shortly to be had and solemnized between the above bound Austin Howard and Miss Elizabeth J. Boone (Mother of Young Lady gave Consent in writing duly proven by oath of Leo Boone)

for which purpose a License has been this day issued by the Clerk of the County Court of Nelson County, in the State of Kentucky: Now, therefore, in case there shall be no lawful cause to obstruct the said Marriage, then the above obligation shall be void, otherwise the same be and remain in full force and virtue.
