

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we *Joseph Mattingly & Geo. Whittely* are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Kentucky, in the sum of fifty pounds current money; to be paid to the said Commonwealth, to which payment well & truly to be made we bind ourselves, our heirs, ex'ors & adm'ors, jointly & severally by these presents; sealed with our seals and dated this *13<sup>th</sup>* day of *June* 1812.

THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if there is no lawful cause to obstruct a marriage, intended to be solemnized shortly, between the above bound *Joseph Mattingly & Betsey*

*Hagan* both being above the age of *twenty one years* when the above obligation to be void; else to remain in full force.
