

Know all men by these presents that we Francis Peak & Joseph Edelen are held and firmly bound unto the Commonwealth of Kentucky in the sum of fifty pounds current money to be paid to our said Commonwealth to which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs executors and assigns jointly and severally by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 31st day of August 1826

The condition of obligation is, that if there is no lawful cause to obstruct a marriage intended to be solemnized shortly between the above bound Francis Peak and Mrs Mary French the widow of William French then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force
