



Know all men by these presents that we Francis Peak

our seals and dated this 7th day of January 1817.
The condition of the above obligation is such, that if there
is no lawful cause to obstruct a marriage, intended to be solemnized
shortly, between the above bound Francis Peak and Mrs. Susann
na Ellison the widow of Enock Ellison

then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force
