money, to be paid to the said Commonwealth & to whose pay-  
ment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves our he-  
irs & admors jointly & severally by these presents, sealed  
our seals and dated this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January 1817.

The condition of the above obligation is such, that if there  
is no lawful cause to obstruct a marriage, intended to be solemnized  
shortly, between the above bound Francis Peak and Eliza  
Ellison the widow of Enock Ellison

then the above obligation to be void else to remain in full force
