THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if there is no lawful cause to obstruct a marriage, intended to be solemnized shortly, between the above bound *Lewis Stiles and Miss Rebecca Griffith daughter of Griffith Willett*
